## DAN MAHLER

- Dan resides on Lorrie Lane with his wife, Marie and their three children, Joseph, Ashley, and Morgan. He has been a resident of Wanaque for over 32 years.
- Dan is a graduate of Rutgers University with a BS degree in Business and an MBA in Professional Accounting. Dan also has a Masters Degree in Federal Income Taxation from Seton Hall University. Dan is a Certified Public Accountant with over 34 years experience. Dan is currently the managing partner of Gisler & Mahler Certified Public Accountants, located on Main Street in Bloomingdale.
- Dan is currently serving his 4<sup>th</sup> year as Mayor. During Dan's tenure as Mayor some of the improvements to Wanaque Borough include: the Haskell Town Center Building, the Holiday Inn, the reconstruction of the Addice Park and Wanaque School Ballfields, the new Hagstrom Ballfields and the re-paving of over 15 streets and roadways.
- Prior to becoming Mayor, Dan served for 14 years on the Council, including three terms as Council President. Dan also served as Chairman of the Finance, Insurance, Sewer, Playgrounds, Recreation, Town Picnic, New Construction, Buildings and Grounds, Negotiations and Personnel Committees. In 1993, Dan was Chairman of the Wanaque 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Parade and Picnic. As Chairman of Recreation, Dan coordinated the planning and redesign of Back Beach Park. As Playgrounds Chairman, Dan coordinated the construction of six new playgrounds, including the playgrounds at both elementary schools, and the renovation of two existing playgrounds.

- Dan is an active member of the Wanaque Republican Club. He served as Republican Boro Leader from November 2005 until June 2006.
- Prior to his term on the Council, Dan served on Wanaque's Recycling and Industrial Commissions and on the Wanaque Board of Adjustment.
- Dan was an active member of the Wanaque Jaycees for 19 years, holding numerous offices including President. Dan is a life member of the Jaycees. Dan organized numerous Jaycee projects involving our children, including Easter Egg Hunts, Halloween Parades, Santa Visits, Safetytown and more. Dan was involved with bringing the Safetytown program to Wanaque 30 years ago. Jaycee Park, on Tremont Terrace was started during Dan's term as President in 1982.
- Dan also served 5 years as a Little League Manager and 2 years as a coach. Dan also coached soccer. Dan had served as the accountant for the Wanaque Little League for almost 20 years, donating his time in preparing their Non-Profit Tax Returns at no charge. Dan also provides the same services for the Wanaque Coaches Association, the Wanaque Golden Age Club and the Wanaque VFW.
